- Academic activities


Examination

 - Written in the last study year







- Study group of 2 to 8 participants
- You study literature together
- Discuss questions and explain to each other
- Helps you prepare for the exam

Interactive practice

- Study groups of 2-8 participants
- You practice together practical aspects of the study (Pulse and Tongue diagnosis, anamnesis, techniques)
- You discuss case histories
- Helps you prepare for the exams



You meet up with each other, before or after the class weekends, or during the week. You can almost always use classrooms at Shenzhou.

Some meet at home or e.g. in a library or other public place.



 3rd year 120 hrs




Apprenticeship agenda

Theory exams

- Midterm exam after 5th class weekend

Practical exams

- final exam in June/July
 - Foundations of Traditional Chinese Medicine > Tongue and Pulse exam
 - Acupuncture 1st year > Acupuncture point location and needling techniques
 - Practical case study, treatment plan, point selection and demonstration of treatment

Thesis

Written in the last study year, introduction into academic research and writing





- Send documents along with your registration
